### 'Beethoven Concerto-thon' Project: Autumn 2024

This event is a St George's fund-raising project towards a stage extension that will support the weight of a grand piano (so that Romantic piano concertos can be regularly performed in future). Community orchestras of Bristol are all joining forces in a day event to raise several thousand pounds towards this cost. The event is organised by St George's. BMet have been allocated **Beethoven's Third Piano Concerto in C minor**, an absolute masterwork with local young soloist, Henry Lewis. The rehearsals will mostly be tied in with the usual autumn term rehearsals.

N.B. Sadly, not all of the orchestra can take part in this event due to space on the main stage (no stage extension and there's a Steinway to fit on), so this will be reduced forces.



# This season...

Bartók's *Concerto for Orchestra* is arguably one of the greatest achievements of the twentieth century. It draws from a vast array of traditional musical inspirations, with orchestration that vividly captures diverse styles and colours. True to its title as a 'concerto' (grosso) for orchestra rather than a 'symphony,' it offers a balanced distribution of melodies, presenting significant challenges for all and an exhilarating experience. The rest of the programme is equally captivating, highlighting the striking rhythms of Eastern Europe.

The Spring term shifts focus to the USA, drawing from its traditional musical heritage. This lively and accessible programme, featuring works by John Williams, Copland, and Bernstein, promises to be a crowd-pleaser, with the potential to fill St George's. While William Grant Still and Florence Price may be less familiar, their stunning compositions are sure to win your hearts, leaving melodies that will stay with you forever.

In the Summer term, we return to Clifton Cathedral for the 'Clifton International Festival of Music,' where we performed in 2023. Strauss's *Four Last Songs* is a firm favorite, especially among vocal music enthusiasts, who make up a large portion of the festival audience. The other German masterpieces, along with Ravel, whose anniversary we acknowledge, have not been performed by the Metropolitan Orchestra in many years. Brahms' *Third Symphony* is a brilliant work, showcasing the finest of his writing, and offers a chance for us to revel in the rich, open sonorities which the cathedral space enhances.
